The Government of Liberia has received additional financing from the International Development Association (IDA), toward the cost of the **Liberia Accelerated Electricity Expansion Project (LACEEP-AF)**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include assisting the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) to supervise and manage the Contracts for the Construction of 66/22kV & 66/33kV Substations, 66kV Transmission Lines and 22kV&33kV Distribution Networks and Customer Connections in Monrovia and in Bomi & Grand Cape Mount Counties. The assignment shall also entail the review of Contractors’ detailed designs and other submittals. Specific tasks that will be performed and completed over a contract period of not more than sixteen months will include:

- Review of all Contractors’ Submittals to LEC
- Accompany LEC Technical staff for Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT)

- Construction Supervision including Monitoring the compliance of Environmental and Social management plans of the project
- Contracts Management and Administration

The Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) now invites applications from **eligible consulting firms (Consultants)** to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

A firm:

- With at least 15 years of demonstrable knowledge and experience in the engineering design, construction supervision and contract management of Transmission and Distribution (T&D) projects.
- Must have in the last 10 years managed at least 2 similar T&D projects, one of which must have been in a South Saharan African Country with conditions similar to Liberia.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's ***Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers [January 2011 and revised in July, 2014]*** ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
